Background of the TWE+ project



- Teachers and mobility:
 - **Leuven Communiqué** - importance of increasing the number of students and staff participating in various mobility activities internationally
 - A key factor in the internationalisation strategies (**Erasmus Impact Study 2014**)
 - Teaching mobility has a positive impact on student mobility (according to the **REALISE KA2 project**)
 - But: obstacles and lack of access
 - Recognition, motivation, networking
 - Needs more attention and exploration

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

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Research and Quality and Impact Tool



• Research

- Putting more focus on the importance of teaching mobility
- Aims to identify and define the quality aspects of teaching mobility
- Discovers factors that affect the quality of teaching mobility
- Organizational and personal elements as well

• Quality & Impact Tool for Teaching Mobility Assessment

- Based on the research
- Quality assurance tool for teaching mobilities
- Can be used on European, institutional and individual levels



Catalogue of pedagogical tools & methods



- Training of teaching staff in pedagogy in higher education is relatively new in Europe
- Institutional and national practices are highly variable
- Using innovative pedagogical tools and methods can significantly impact the quality of teaching mobility
- Importance of pedagogical methodology during the pandemic
 - Digital solutions



Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility Platform



- Previously no central platform that provides a database of opportunities to (especially junior) teaching staff
- IMOTION and staffmobility.eu
- The platform was designed to offer and find opportunities for teaching mobility online
- Individual academic profiles
